Our Music School offers programs in 30+ instruments and voice for all ages in all musical styles with a faculty of 70+ professional teaching artists.

We are seeking motivated, enthusiastic college or post-college string interns to assist our Youth Orchestra Directors during their weekly Saturday rehearsals. There are two openings for violin/viola interns and one opening for a cello intern.

PRIMARY AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY:

Youth Orchestra Interns will have as their primary responsibility to assist the Youth Orchestra Directors during their Saturday morning rehearsals. The Sinfonia Concert Orchestra led by Director Ken Culver rehearses on Saturdays from 9:30am to 12pm, and the Camerata Strings led by Director Jennifer Perkins rehearse on Saturdays from 9:30am to 11am.

Job Responsibilities include but are not limited to: Attending weekly rehearsals, performing in concerts as ringers if needed, checking attendance, leading sectionals, assisting students during rehearsals, helping with music (bowings, copies, etc.) and managing students. The main role for Interns is to be a resource for the Youth Orchestra Directors in helping to create a positive, effective, and engaging rehearsal atmosphere.

The Youth Orchestra Interns will report to the Class and Ensemble Manager and the Youth Orchestra Directors. They must maintain strong working relationships with students and directors, while following all policies and procedures of Groton Hill Music School.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Ideal candidates are individuals ages 18 and up with strong playing skills who exhibit excellence in leadership, decision making, communication, teamwork, critical thinking, patience, and acting as a role model for young music students.
