Groton Hill Music Center is the region's premier nonprofit center for outstanding music education, professional performances, and community engagement programs. Our Community Engagement Program is partnering with Lowell's Afternoon in the Arts Program and we are in need of a **Beginning/Intermediate Band Instructor**.

Students enrolled in this program will receive both group and ensemble-based instruction on an instrument of their choice. Instruments offered are: Flute, Clarinet, Oboe, Bassoon, Trumpet, French Horn, Trombone, Euphonium, Tuba, and Percussion.

PRIMARY AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY:

This position entails teaching on Monday and Wednesday from 4:00pm - 6:30pm at Lowell High School. Instructors will instruct age appropriate band pieces to a large group of beginner to intermediate players. They will be responsible for instructing students on how to play, directing sectional rehearsals, teaching students how to care for their instruments and aim for two student performances.

Groton Hill faculty members are responsible for: 1) inspiring and sharing their love of music with their students; 2) setting a high bar for students' levels of technical skill and musicality; 3) clearly communicating expectations and working toward shared goals; and 4) advocating for their students to engage in additional Groton Hill Music School programs to deepen their musical development and their commitment to their studies.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Ideal candidates should have a degree in music and a minimum of three years of teaching experience. The applicant should have band director experience and expertise in working with large ensembles.
