*Groton Hill Music Center, a community music school in Groton, MA with a faculty of 60+ professional teaching artists, has an opening beginning in the fall for a part-time **Group Ukulele Instructor** as part of our outreach efforts at the **Boys & Girls Club of Leominster and Gardner**. The role involves beginner group ukulele instruction to elementary- and middle-school age students.*

PRIMARY AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY:

This position entails **school year** teaching on Wednesday afternoons, from 3-5pm beginning September 19th and ends June 14th. School year students are grouped by age: 8-12 and 13-16, respectively. Students 8-12 will have a 1 hr class from 3-4pm and students aged 13-16 will have class from 4-5pm. The vacancy also calls for **summer** weekday teaching once per week, three hour-long periods from 3-6pm; the particular weekday is yet to be determined, but will be consistent from week to week.

Groton Hill faculty members are responsible for: 1) inspiring and sharing their love of music with their students; 2) setting a high bar for students' levels of technical skill and musicality; 3) clearly communicating expectations and working toward shared goals; and 4) advocating for their students to engage in additional Groton Hill Music School programs to deepen their musical development and their commitment to their studies.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Ideal candidates should have a degree in music and a minimum of three years of teaching experience, as well as proficiency on ukulele and experience leading children in song.
